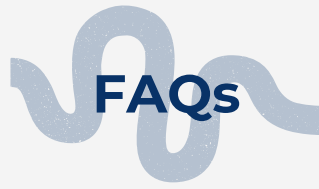




ABOUT US

Iaomai Academy is a drop-in learning center for children in grades K-8 where we celebrate individual learning styles and foster academic growth. Our program is designed to support high-achieving students, including those with mild learning differences, who are motivated to succeed. We partner with parents to provide a place of acceptance and hope for children who need a smaller setting to thrive. Our core values are rooted in **laomai** (pronounced ee-ah'-om-ahee), a biblical concept of healing that seeks to restore and bring one back from the darkness. Iaomai Academy offers a relaxed environment for children to engage in self-paced learning and enrichment activities with scheduled breaks throughout the day to support this goal.



Is Iaomai Academy an accredited school?

We are a drop-in learning center that acts as a part-time supplement for homeschool children in grades K-8.

Students must be registered as homeschoolers with their local school district, but we provide progress reports twice a year to help show evidence of progress required by the state.

What type of child is a good fit for your program?

Iaomai Academy is best for high-achieving and/or independent, motivated learners who are struggling in larger schools or need homeschool support due to things such as anxiety or social connection.

Do you support students with special needs?

While we support a range of learning needs, we are not a special education program and are unable to serve students with significant learning differences or developmental delays.

Children with mild learning disorders, including twice-exceptional (2e), may apply if they have an official diagnosis and strong determination to learn.
